LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is pleased to support this important initiative. Working with our partners at DC Water, DDOT's Public Space Regulation Division (PSRD) has identified a streamlined process to assist you with performing this vital work to support public health and citizen's wellbeing.

- Instructions on DDOT permits and waivers
 - Permits are not needed for work done exclusively beyond the sidewalk, including work in the public parking area.
 - All materials, equipment, tools, etc. must be hand carried or carried via hand cart across the sidewalk to the work area.
 - This includes permits to repair/replace IN KIND ONLY fences and retaining walls.
 - Any changes to these including materials, height, layout will require a public space construction permit.
 - DDOT strongly recommends not changing these items.
 - DDOT does not issue permits to reserve curbside space for contractor's vehicles, including if the vehicle is bringing materials, equipment, tools, etc. See the note above about hand-carrying those to the site.
 - The contractor can obtain parking passes for contractor's vehicles on Residential Parking Permit streets via any of the following:

 - If construction is required in the sidewalk, tree box, or curb lane a Construction Staging Area permit must be obtained online at tops.ddot.dc.gov under the Occupancy Permit type.
 - When feasible please use one of our typical traffic control plans for any low volume street.
