
## **dCó** DC Clean Rivers Project Background: Water Quality Benefits



## **dCo** Northwest Boundary Tunnel Project: Benefits

#### Anacostia River CSO System


- Over 14.7 billion gallons captured to date
- Over 9,300 tons of trash, debris, and other solids captured
- Exceeding predicted capture rate (90%>80%)
- First year in operation was the wettest year on record for the District of Columbia




- Reduce the frequency and magnitude of street flooding
- Significantly mitigate the frequency, magnitude, and duration of sewer flooding and basement backups in the Northeast Boundary drainage area
- Reduce risks to human health
- Control \*combined sewer overflow (CSO) discharges to the Anacostia River, significantly improving water quality
- Prevent deterioration of historic resources from water damage caused by flooding

# **CC** Northeast Boundary Tunnel Project

Testity: Safe and Ho Resilient

- 23' diameter tunnel, 5 miles long
- Largest project ever implemented by DC Water (\$580 M)
- Designed to:
  - $\circ$  Provide CSO control
  - Mitigate flooding <u>in specific chronic areas up to 15-year 24-hour storm</u> (the current design standard for the system)

• Will not eliminate flooding for a larger storm, but will mitigate the impact

Consent Decree requires project to be placed in operation by March 23, 2025. <u>The project was accelerated</u> after Bloomingdale/LeDroit Park flooding in 2012 and is planned to be placed in service in summer 2023

## **CC** The DC Flood Task Force

- Established by the Office of City Administrator (OCA) in September 2021
- Purpose: identify policies and projects to bolster flood readiness while equitably protecting the District's residents and economy from the damage that floods
- Chair: Deputy Mayor for Operations and Infrastructure (DMOI)
- Co-chairs: Director of the Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) and the Chief Executive Officer and General Manager of DC Water



# dCd Restoration Plan for Cooper Gordon Park

- Plant 3 Willow Oaks
- Plant 9 Crepe Myrtles which bloom with attractive bark
- Plant shrubs, grasses, blooming perennials, and ground covers
- Restore the original ornamental iron fencing in the park as well as the Cooper memorial sign. A new Gordon memorial sign will be added.
- Install 3 new park benches
- Install an irrigation system with a rain sensor to water the plants
- The Commission of Arts and Humanities will manage the process for commissioning new art to be installed in the park

# **CC** NEBT Claims Process



- If you are a property owner and you believe that construction activities undertaken as a result of this project have damaged your property in some way, you may send an email to <u>dccleanrivers@dcwater.com</u> or call the Hotline at 800-988-6151.
- A representative of the contractor, SIH, will contact you to receive the information for the claim. A claim will be initiated on your behalf and a copy will be transmitted to you. Further communications about the claim will occur between the property owner and DC Water's insurance company.
- The claim receives a claim number, and an adjuster investigates.
- It is recommended that when you see damage, report it.
